Maths and Numeracy	Imagine you're selling tickets for a school play. Create a price list and calculate total earnings from different ticket combinations.	Research the gross profit of ten films and put in order from lowest grossing to highest
Languages, Literacy and Communication	Watch a children's film and write a review including plot summary, favourite moments, and star rating.	Write a short script for a scene set in a magical theatre. Include stage directions and dialogue.
Science and Technology	Create sound effects for a dramatic scene using household items. Explain how each sound adds to the atmosphere.	Use a digital tool (e.g., Canva, PowerPoint) to create a poster for an imaginary film or play. Include title, tagline, and visuals.
Expressive Arts	Design and decorate a mask for a character in a play or film. Write a short paragraph explaining the character's personality and role.	Choose a character from a film or play and design three costume ideas for different scenes
Humanities	Research and create a timeline showing key moments in the history of theatre (e.g., Ancient Greek theatre, Shakespeare, modern musicals).	Investigate a local theatre or performance space in Wales. What shows have been performed there? Who uses it?
Health and Wellbeing	Reflect on a time you performed or spoke in front of others. How did it feel? What helped you feel confident?	Create a "pre-performance" routine to help calm nerves—e.g., breathing exercises, positive affirmations, stretches.
