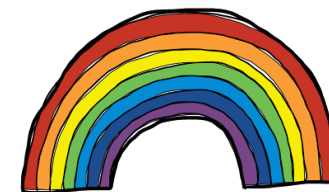

**Can you write 5 fact families?**

Add a 2 digit number to a 1 digit number (e.g.  $27 + 5 = 32$ ). Create a fact family using these 3 numbers e.g.  
 $(27 + 5 = 32$   
 $5 + 27 = 32$   
 $32 - 5 = 27$   
 $32 - 27 = 5)$

**Too easy?** Use 3 digit numbers.

**Can you write sentences using the words from your spelling lists?**

Write as many sentences as you can using the words from your spelling list in your pack. Remember full stops and capital letters. Too easy? Add a conjunction to your sentence (e.g. and, because, so, if, but).

**Choose a times table to recite.**

Choose either 2, 5, 10 times tables. Time yourself using a tablet or a phone to see how quick you can recite them. Record your time in your book. Try again, can you beat your time?

**Too easy?** Try 3, 4, 9 times tables.

**How many smaller words can you make out of the words 'Rainbow Federation'?**

Write out the words 'Rainbow Federation' in your exercise books. Make a list of the smaller words you can make using these letters. Too easy? Do the same with the words "Bryn Hafod" and "Glan Yr Afon".

**Home Learning Topic Task Task Overview**

**Imagine a new theme park will be built in Llanrumney.**

You will be the new manager of the theme park and will have to think of a name for your theme park. Below is a list of the tasks you need to think of:


- Draw a map of your theme park using a key
- Design a ride(s) to go into your theme park.
- Create a menu for the café in your theme park.
- Design items for the gift shop, (e.g. badge, magnet, pencil). Don't forget to include the price of the items
- Create a leaflet to advertise your theme park.

**Can you sort numbers between odd and evens?**  
Split your page in half – odd column and even column.  
Sort numbers up to 100 into odd and even columns.  
**Too easy?** Sort numbers between 100 and 200.

**Use the features of a set of instructions on how to wash your hands.**  
Draw a comic strip including pictures showing the steps of how to wash your hands properly. Make sure the pictures are in the correct order.  
**Too easy?** Think of a bossy verb to go with each picture, for example, scrub.

- Create a promotional video for your theme park using a digital device.  
**You can use ICT devices such as phones, tablets and iPads. Or you can choose to use pen and paper to complete these tasks. Spread these activities out over the week.**  
**Be as creative as you can!**

**Can you sort numbers using a Venn diagram?**



Use a Venn diagram (as above) to sort the numbers in the 2 times tables and 10 times tables. Don't forget if the number is in both times tables it goes in the middle!  
**Too easy?** Try sorting numbers from 6 times tables and 8 times tables.

**Write up your set of instructions for washing your hands.**  
Use your comic strip from yesterday to write up your set of instructions on how to wash your hands. Remember to include numbered steps in the right order, time connectives, bossy verbs.  
**Too easy?** Add a top tip to finish your instructions.

**Can you halve and double numbers?**  
Make a list of ten 2 digit-numbers. What is double and halve of these numbers?  
**Too easy?** Try to double and halve ten 3-digit numbers.

**Edit and improve your set instructions.**  
Redraft your instructions using your neatest handwriting. Double check for capital letters, full stops.  
**Too easy?** Can you add an adverb (e.g. carefully, slowly) before your bossy verbs? (e.g. Carefully scrub the back of your hands. Cheerfully sing 'Happy Birthday' twice.)
