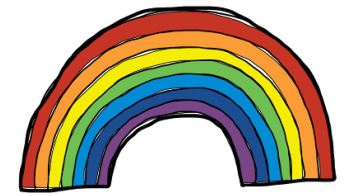

Play Eye Spy. Find the letters o in words around the house eg, on books, newspapers, posters, food labels. Practice writing the letters o. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TYYSBProJH4</p> <p>Date completed</p>	<p>Home Learning Topic Task Task Overview</p> <p>Write about and draw a picture of what you have been doing at home.</p>
<p>realise that anything can be counted, not just objects, e.g. claps, steps Ask your child to clap 4 times, jump 3 times, etc. Encourage your child to count each clap or jump they perform so that they will have jumped or clapped the amount of times you have asked for.</p> <p>Date completed</p>	<p>Using the pack provided ask your child your instructions in the game Listen and Colour Three Key Words.</p> <p>Play Simon Says.</p> <p>Date completed</p>	

<p>Look for patterns around your home. Can your child spot any patterns? Your child can then make a pattern using objects from around the house eg, spoon, fork, spoon, fork. or draw a pattern using 2 colours.</p> <p>Date completed</p>	<p>Play letter games. https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/flash-cards?phase=2</p> <p>Date completed</p>	
<p>Full and empty; get a plastic cup or container. Ask your child to show you a full cup and then an empty one. You then swap and your child has to ask you to show them a full and empty cup. Talk about full, nearly full, half full, nearly empty and empty..</p> <p>Date completed</p>	<p>Practise your child's name. You write your child's name (Capital letter only on the first letter of their name) and your child can write over your writing or copy underneath.</p> <p>Date completed</p>	
<p>Taller / shorter. Have fun with the whole family! Put yourselves in order from the tallest to the shortest. Ask your child Who is the tallest? Who is the shortest?</p> <p>Date completed</p>	<p>Share a book with your child, discuss the pictures, characters, what happens and what might happen next. Can your child find the sound 'ck' in the story?</p> <p>Date completed</p>
