Maths and Numeracy	Investigate currency in Egypt - what is it? Value compared to 1 GBP.	Design a pyramid using materials like sugar cubes or blocks, calculating cubes needed for each layer and the total.
Languages, Literacy and Communication	Research Howard Carter - who was he and what did he do?	Create a diary entry for Howard Carter and his tomb excavation
Science and Technology	Simulate mummification by preserving an apple slice with baking soda and salt, recording observations over days.	Build a model shaduf using household items, test it, and write about its function in crop irrigation.
Expressive Arts	Create an Egyptian-style artwork inspired by tomb paintings, carvings, or statues, using materials available at home.	Compose a simple musical performance inspired by Egyptian life, using homemade instruments or vocal sounds.
Humanities	Draw or print a map of Ancient Egypt, labeling the Nile, major cities, and landmarks, and explain the importance of the Nile.	Research an Egyptian god or goddess and create a fact file, visually presenting the deity's role, powers, and symbols.
Health and Wellbeing	Learn Egyptian-inspired dance moves and create a short sequence focusing on balance and coordination.	Write a diary imagining life as an Ancient Egyptian, reflecting on work, diet, and relationships.
